- 1. Welcome and introductions / determination of quorum

 - Gerry Miller called the meeting to order at 5:15 PM.
- 2. Public Comment/Short General Discussion Period, Adjust Agenda
 - Larry stated that he created some maps of Lamoille Canyon using the USGS topomap builder.
- 3. Approval of February 8th meeting minutes
 - Gerry made a motion to approve the minutes from the February meeting. Andi seconded and the motion passed.
- 4. Treasurer's Report:
 - Approval of Bills Accrued Since the Last Meeting
 - i. \$14,360 in the checking account as of February 2022. Larry made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Pam seconded and the motion passed.
 - ii. Andi and Katie will work on the Nevada Gold Mines proposal and will include Sage Grouse Experience and Friends of the Ruby Mountains projects.

 - i. Leslie stated that there is funding available for trail building training. BLM will be implementing burrowing owl and raptor surveys. Doug would like to walk the trail to get a feel for the steepness of the grades and for possible meander implementation.

 - Friends and NOS hosted a snowshoe hike at the California Trail Center on March 18 at 7:30 PM. The y will be providing a campfire where the public will be able to drink hot cocoa and make s'mores.

- 9. Updates: Sagebrush Seed Collection, Roads End Education Area, Boot Cleaning Station, Lamoille Canyon Chronological Photopoint on the Range 2 Fire, Cowboy Poetry Panel Discussion, Educational Workshops Planned for Mid-Winter
 - Doug and Brandolyn were able to lock down a re-photography site in Lamoille Canyon, looking at cottonwood regeneration. A letter to the Forest Service has been drafted and submitted.
 - The noxious weeds awareness boot scraping station has been delivered and will be installed at Lamoille Canyon Roads End by FS crews sometime this spring.
 - Virtual fencing presentation will be given by Paul at the April annual dinner.

- 12. Sage Grouse Local Area Working Group Update Elko has a few credit and debit opportunities in the works and the Nevada Sagebrush Ecosystem Council is also considering the Lahontan Cutthroat Habitat, Mule Deer Corridors and other issues facing the Sagebrush landscapes
 - The Sagebrush Ecosystem Council would like LAWGs to refer to management plans and mitigate triggers as they come up. Rules are changing statewide and more corridors will be implemented.
 - The Scope has been completed and comments are being reviewed. The Sage Grouse Experience will be held virtually this year and there will be photos that will be linked for the public to view.
 - NDOW is currently looking for lek counters. There will also be a sagebrush planting event at the Cedar Fire on March 19th from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.
 - Jeff Knight (NDA) will be hosting a grasshopper training on March 30th.

 - i. Currently in the process of all of their pre-season planning for fire and hiring for seasonal positions. Meagan Carter will be starting a 120-day detail as the deputy district ranger next week.
