## NNSG BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES

- 1. Welcome and introductions determination of quorum

  - Andi called the meeting to order at 5:15 PM.
- . Public Comment/Short General Discussion Period, Adjust Agenda
  - Nick stated that he is interested in becoming a BOD member this fall.
  - There will be a meeting with NDOT on February 9<sup>th</sup> where the expansion of the multi-use trail from Elko to the Trails Center will be discussed.
- 3. Approval of December meeting minutes

- 6. BLM Mary's River riparian assessment:
  - a. Do we want to do a follow-up study since we have the funds for it, but we no longer manage the land?
    - NNSG has roughly \$30,000 to do an assessment or a study on the Mary's River. To move forward, we would have to submit a proposal in writing to the BLM. Melanie would like to see some sort of project proposal from NNSG. Andi contacted Greg Simmons and he does have the old data files from the original assessment. Open Range Consulting is interested in taking on the project and would like to do a new survey. Those present discussed different ideas of how BLM could cost share with us on getting monitoring completed, like a 50:50 cost share.

  - The NOS snowshoe hike in December had 8 participants. Need to think about parking during the winter months moving forward.

- 1. Doug stated that he will help to organize. Andi will reach out to Jesse Braatz to see if he'd be interested in presenting on the Humboldt River Ranch beaver project with Carol Evans and John Elliot. Nick has climate change contacts in Carson that he can reach out to. Other presenters could include John Griggs and Mark Paris. Doug will contact GBC to see when GTA 130 is available this fall. Theme for symposium: Climate Change in Great Basin Ecosystems/Adaptive Ecosystem Resilience. Rachel Buzzetti (Nevada Rangelands) has funding available for educational opportunities.
- iii. Rangeland monitoring workshop March 2023
  - 1. Paul stated that he is available February 21-24 and March 6-8 to hold the workshop in Elko. He'd like to give a one-hour presentation giving an overview of some monitoring practices and then showcase some ranchers and their operations. Brad at WCF would like to see a proposal from Paul and Dave is also interested in helping to give the presentation.

They would like to include discussion on pertinent books, plant and gut health information with regards to soil health in Nevada. - Lamoille summit trails partnership update
  - i. Leslie stated that the quarterly report was submitted to RTP and now funds were spent during that time due to snow. Southfork State Park would like to have their trail system connect to the summit trail sometime in the future. They are working on their MOU for corner crossings on public and private lands.

- Lamoille Canyon chronolog photopoint on the Range 2 fire
