Weed Extravaganza March 19<sup>th</sup> at the Convention Center. Invasive Annual Grass Webinar series coming up in April hosted by the University of Wyoming.

  - Microbiome working group update

  - Lamoille summit trails partnership update (ETSI)
    - i. The grant for the staging area is two years out and NEPA is currently underway. It's about 70% completed. Leslie is working on the website: ElkoTrailsWorkshop.com. She submitted a funding request to the BLM to get trails on the ground in 2025. Received a funding award for a feasibility study and working on an assistance agreement with the BLM. NDOT sent her a note that they will fund a feasibility study.
